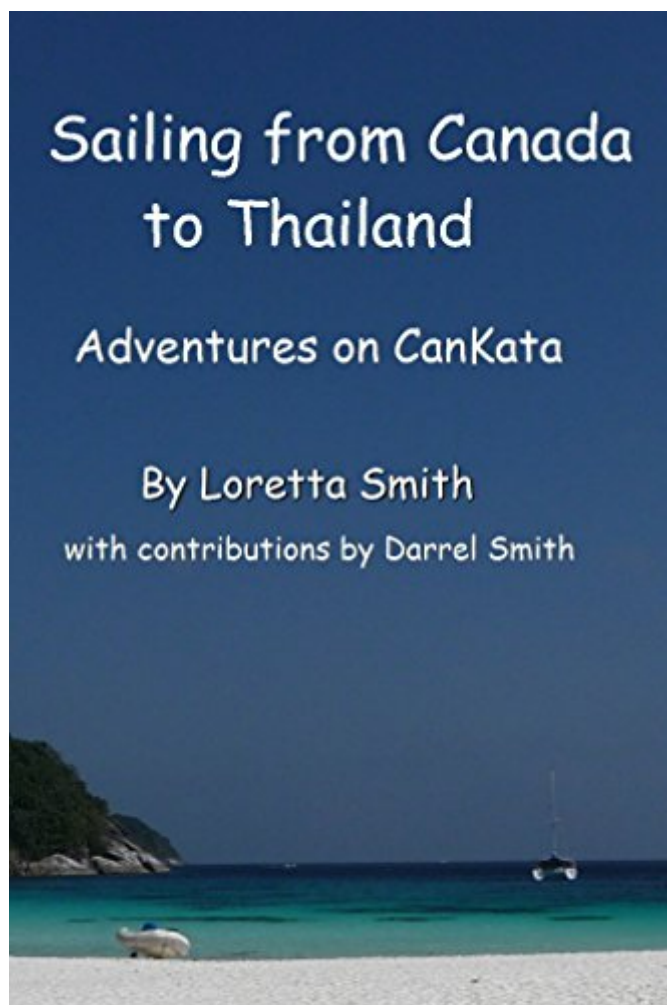

This book was a little too cutesy (how many times do you need to say yummy or mmm-mmm?) for me. I also prefer a bit more about the actual sailing. The author does write reasonably well, which allows for an enjoyable book, but I prefer books where the writing assumes the audience has more intelligence. Yummy and tasty might be fine for holiday cooking shows, but become annoying reading. Still, I did finish it. If the author does a follow up, I hope she'll mix in more sailing and less of the kiddee talk. I'd read that.
