

This was a baby bedtime favorite for us - and it still finds its way into the rotation five years later. So sweet and calming. A friend raising black children gave this to us (raising white daughters) in a package of books featuring nonwhite characters so that our daughters could see children who looked like hers. One of the most meaningful gifts we received.

My 2.5 year old has loved this book for about a year now and shows no signs of losing interest! It is

one of his favorite bedtime books. At first he just loved the story, but now that he's able to count along he likes to do so. The pictures are lovely--richly detailed and beautifully drawn. My son loves to point out the cat, talk about how the little girl is reading bedtime stories with her dad just like he's doing with me, etc. I can see why this book has won awards! It's one of those special books that appeals to children's-book-loving adults as well as the children themselves. I'd recommend this title to anyone looking for a new story to add to the bedtime routine. Edited to add: Our second boy also loves this book as much as his older brother did. He especially loves to put his feet on the book to show that his toes match up with the little girl in the story. I've also started giving this as a new baby present to just about every new baby I know, and I've gotten nothing but compliments on it. Truly a lovely, timeless story!

I got this for my husband as a small "push present" at the birth of our daughter. I wanted a cute daddy-daughter book for them to read. This isn't really emotional or even particularly father/daughter-themed. It fell flat and is just not what I was hoping for.

At one year, baby already has four bins of books. This is one of her favorites. Simple, colorful illustrations. She loves the baby girls/daddy interactions. She loves the cat and the stuffed animals that appear in many of the illustrations ... points to the animals and has us name them. She also points to the big, bold numbers on each page spread (10, 9, 8 ...) and has us say the number out loud.

My daughter loves this book! She sees the dad holding the little girl and screams "Daddy!" at each page and points to him. Great positive black family imagery!

I'm a little surprised how much my 18-month old daughter loves this book. She won't submit to bedtime until I read it one or twice (or three times). The simple, rhythmic words have a Goodnight Moon feel and countdown to bedtime with a little girl and her dad. Simple and sweet.

Adorable book. One sentence per page so it's perfect for my 1 year old.

My 21 month old grandson is not interested in the book. After the first page he starts saying "done" and closes the page. The quality of the product is good. It shipped quickly.
