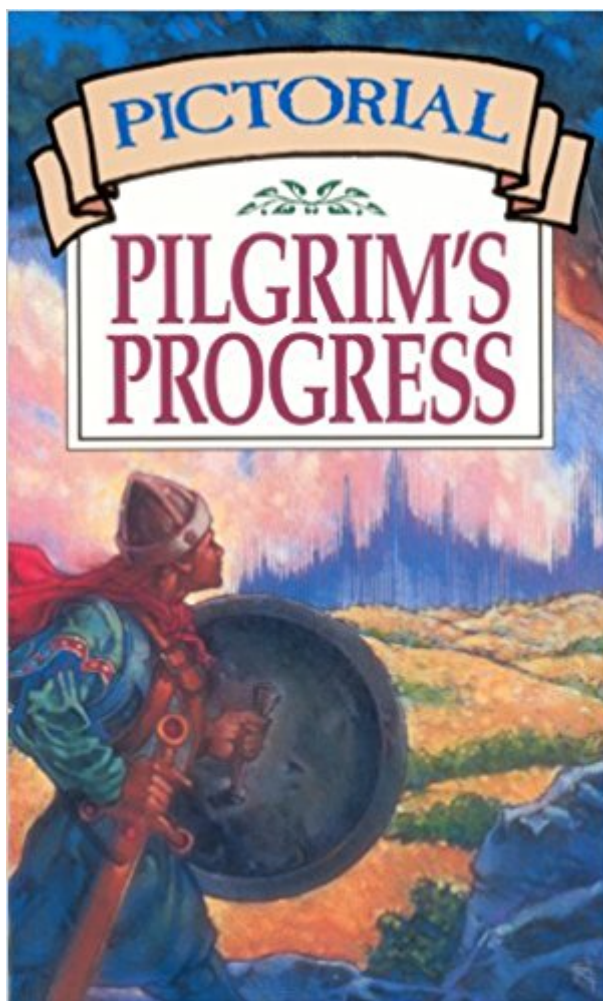

What a delightful way to introduce children to Bunyan's classic! I bought this on a recommendation from a friend and my 6 year old boy and 4 year old girl LOVE IT! We have actually read it several times because the children have begged me. This version is simpler, touching on most of the scenes but only dedicating one page or so to each scene/character that Christian meets. For every page there is a black and white sketched illustration which is appealing to children. My 6 and 4 year

olds have remembered and referred to the characters and lessons learned in this book time and time again, which is impressive. All that said, I read a TON to my kids; if your children aren't used to reading much then I would hold off until they have a better attention span and vocabulary. But if your kids LOVE reading and learning, this book is one of the best you can get your children, ESPECIALLY if you're a fan of the full Pilgrim's Progress.

Pilgrims Progress helps you understand the journey of the Christian life and to help you stay on the path because many will come to try to pull you off the path, giving you "worldly advice" that turns you in an alternate direction. The result: you end up far down some rabbit trail somewhere, that leads to a dead end...wasting your time. It is far Better to stay focused on staying on the straight path--the one God is leading you "to come". Trust Him and step out in to the deep! -No matter how far "off" the path you've strayed, it only takes one turn -right where you are-and God will meet you there! He LOVES you.

This book was purchased for a couple of my grandchildren. Pictures in the book help them to see what is happening and helps them to use their imaginations in seeing what someone may have looked like or what a scene from the story may have looked like. The words are easy to understand. We live far away from our grand children but soon will visit the family with this book . I'm looking forward to reading it with them again.

I purchased this book about 26 years ago when my son was little. I read it to him every night. He remembers it among all the other books I read to him, in spite of the fact that the pictures were in black and white and the language was not "modern" and simplified. The original Pilgrim's Progress is not/was not a fluffy, feel good message for the general public. It was written to encourage Christians in their walk with the Lord, through trying circumstances, subtle temptations, and powerful enemies. This edition, although formatted for children, in my humble opinion, faithfully replicates Bunyan's allegory and helps children to understand its message, underscored by its illustrations. Children are capable of understanding complex, perhaps discomfiting thoughts. This book is stimulating and I am so thankful to rediscover it...and to read it again to my grandchildren.
