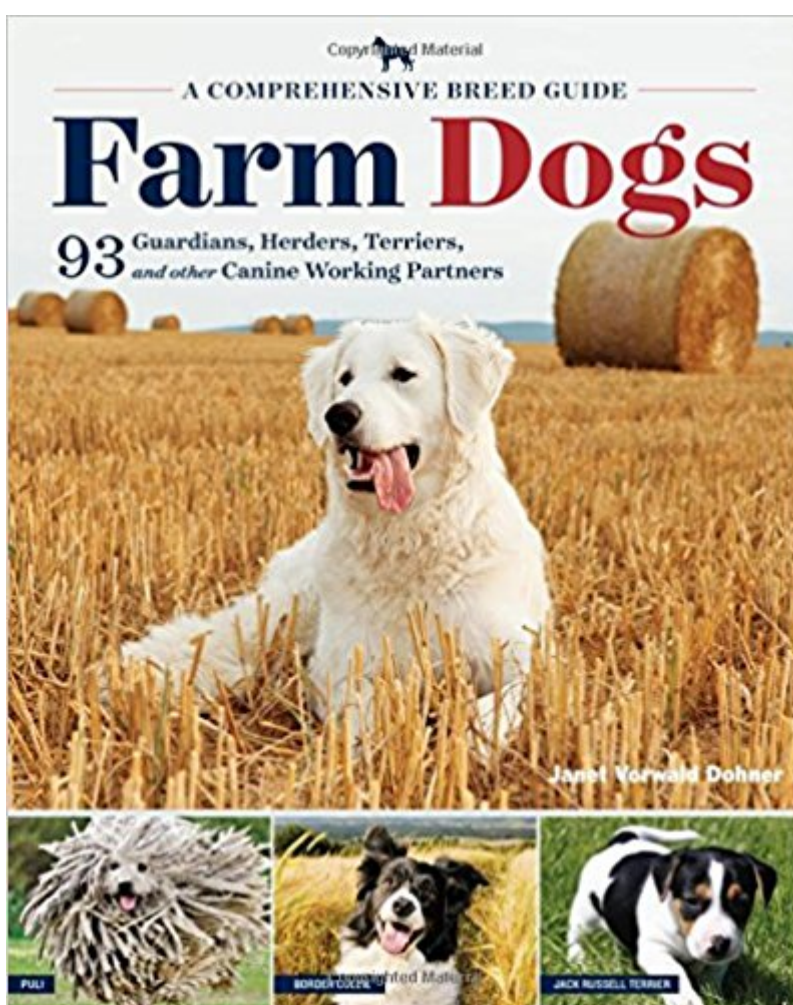

As the title says, this is a very comprehensive breed guide, Janet explains in great detail the roll of each farm dog (herder, livestock guardian, terrier, and general farm dog). And then she provides complete and accurate information about the most common dog breeds in each of these 4 categories, as well as many of the much rarer breeds. She dispels many myths and provides beautiful photographs of each breed. I know that Janet did a ton of research preparing for this book. She spoke to leading authorities about the individual breeds and compiled it all here for us to learn

from. If you only get ONE book, this should be the one.

This book was recommended by someone on a group I belong to. I was looking for a low prey drive breed to add to our farm which can be difficult to find. Bought the book and found 3 breeds that fit our criteria and one of which I had never even thought of. Now we can look for a pup based on breed traits for a breed that with additional training and supervision should be just the dog for the job we want done.

This is a great book. We have had English Shepherds and Australian Shepherds but really knew little or nothing about many of the breeds included in this book. It excels in the breath of information it provides on each breed. There are a couple of farms in our area that use Great Pyrenees to guard their herds of Alpacas and other flocks, so it was especially interesting to read about them. I can't imagine a better guide if you are considering bringing one of these dogs into your life.

First of all, let me say that I own one of the dogs described in the book and the description is spot on. This book is a great resource for all those individuals who need a farm dog or have an interest in dogs that traditionally perform. If you are interested in those breeds, this is really where you should start. You can compare and contrast different breeds and see which of the breed characteristics best suit your needs. From there, you can narrow down your favorite breeds and contact breeders who breed quality representatives. Does this book cover all nuances of each breed? No. I don't think it intends on doing that but it's it is a very comprehensive overview of many breeds. It is as in detail as it can be for what it does (introducing to very many breeds). In addition to providing well researched information, this book is full of beautiful photos. It is a treat to any dog lover, from a beginner to an expert.
