

Nova Academy is a story of a super genius, Theo McCleary, who goes to college for supers to develop their powers. Theo, is a moderately powered super who is not sure he wants to be a super hero, or villain. The world of supers and characters the author created are interesting and well done. This is a great effort by a first time author. The story does have some language and the main character is in a relationship with his girlfriend that does briefly talk about sex, but nothing graphic and it is well done.

What I loved about this book was the realism, battles where fought, people hurt, bled and sometime lost. Everything didn't go great for the good guys and the bad guys weren't unstoppable. Read the sample, you will get hooked and buy the book!!

Well considered universe considering the topic. Interesting main character and romantic interest with several good supporting characters. Biggest weakness was the lame backstory on why the planet had supers, but didn't hold that against him (it would be challenging to find a good reason for this...). The main character is strong, but not overpowered. Fun read if you like the genre and better than most. Given that this seems to be the author's first book, very well done.

For a freshman effort, this novel is pretty good. Is it perfect? No, but it's an entertaining read. The story is about a teenager, graduating high school, who wants to be a Ronin in a world of Super

powered people. He's not willing to live by to the rigid standards of a hero, but he also is not willing to go full villain and join the dark side. One of the problems I have with this is that the author spends too much time explaining that the lead can't pick sides but not enough explaining why. Theo spends the summer dating two girls, one each potentially destined down each road, and he kind of glosses over that summer. I would like to see more "show, don't tell" here. I'd also like to maybe have seen some forshadowing of the Big Secret (or maybe I'm to sense to see it) that is revealed later in the story. I think the author should also have named this in-between state, since Hero and Villain is clearly not all the world has to offer. Most people just live out their daily lives, and there are doubtless more people like Theo, who are basically good intentioned but don't want the strictures of being an official superhero. If there is a Hero Code, an oath of office, or some sort of government sponsored Hero League, it's not explained in the story, nor is the reason Theo feels all heroes are Boy Scouts. I hesitate to use the term anti-hero, because while I think the author may have started out thinking along those lines, Theo doesn't actually move in that direction. He never goes full Punisher or really ever does anything Dark Side. In the end, it kind of watered down the premise, which was that Theo couldn't make up hid mind whether he was good or evil. In fact, he was never truly evil in this story, and he even steps up and takes charge, when he could have just let things slide and let someone else handle it. This speaks volumes about his heart, even if neither the character nor the author are aware of it. (Maybe the author is and is playing the Unreliable Narrator card.)Anyway, it's worth the read, especially if you have Kindle Unlimited. I will be looking for a sequel, should the author keep writing.
