This is an excellent ebook for kids! As a teacher of elementary students, I would love to incorporate this ebook into a small group activity where I present a main idea or topic to the whole class and then they break up in small groups and discover more material on their own. My mind was continuously racing as I read through this book thinking of different projects I could make on this topic. It is the perfect age group to let them use a kindle to explore and what a better way to do so than with this ebook! I will totally let other teachers know of this opportunity and will keep this seller in mind with other ebooks available. I like this book. It's a list of very simple ideas that you can do on a sunny day. The description makes it sound like this would be a bunch of activities that can be done inside, but nearly all of these are outside activities. The sentences are simple so this is a good book for a younger reader to flip through and get ideas for what to do. Each sentence is followed by a full page drawing or picture. I thought it was a little bit odd that the pattern was sentence page for activity 1 - photo page for activity 1 - photo page for activity 2 - sentence page for activity 2- sentence page for activity 3, etc. I imagine this would make sense in a physical book where each sentence page and picture page are facing each other (and then alternating left/right on the next set of pages) but since I was looking at an ebook with only single pages showing at a time, this was a bit strange. It still gets the ideas across though. I also thought it was an unusual choice to do some drawings like on the cover, and some real-life pictures. It's not bad really, but it seems like the author probably just chose one or the other based on what was easily available. It still shows the different ideas well though. Only one idea (Twister) is one that can be played inside. The remaining dozen or so all require being outside: hiking, surfing, roller skating, flying a kite, etc. All of that is appropriate for a sunny day though, so I don't know why the description would advise staying inside. It's still a good book to remind young kids of things you can do outside and practice reading very simple sentences.
