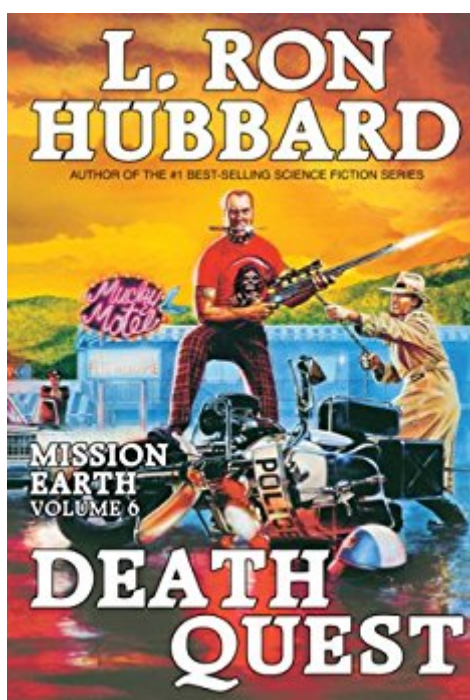

This series started out in typical L. Ron Hubbard style; unfortunately, since Volume 4, it's begun to spiral downward with Volume 6 off on a detour into sexual deviancy which frankly undermines and totally detracts from the story. I'm hoping it's going to get better.

I absolutely loved this satirical fictional description of the 10 tomes series of Mission Earth. The bestselling series was written in the 80s but global societies ills are still prevalent today, as you read it, you will be able to correlate general ideologies such as banking domination, mainstream media brainwashing, widespread use of drugs, promiscuity and much more, and how the hero turns things around for future generations.

It's interesting reading the newspapers and watching TV news now. There was a report today about a laptop in a government office that had a Russian virus on it. Big news! As if that's proof positive the Russians were behind Clinton's email leaks!

The series is entertaining despite the fact that explanations of situations become a little wordy in some cases. Due to this there are lapses in what I consider the action part of the story line, some times for a number of pages. While I understand the author wants the reader to understand the entire story line, the wordiness becomes boring at times.

When L. Ron Hubbard set out to write this series, he wanted to write the biggest science fiction work ever written.
