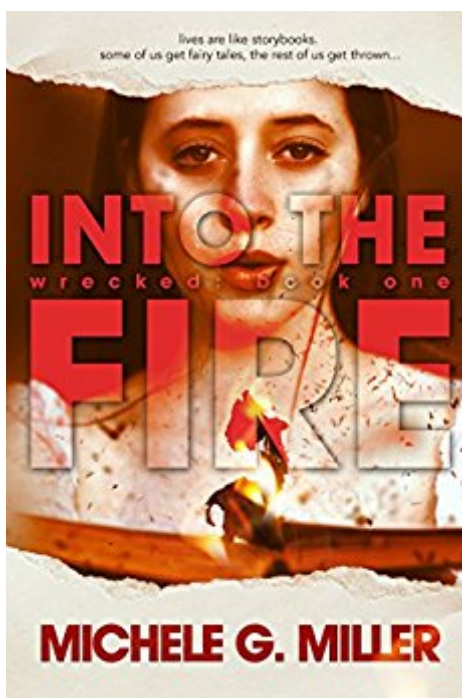


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Into The Fire: A From The Wreckage Standalone Novel (Wrecked Book 1)

story, I was excited but scared because the subject matter was dark. I went in knowing it would take an emotional toll on me. It was heartbreaking and soul crushing, but most importantly, it moved me. After suffering tragic loss and recovering from a terrible accident, Danica struggles with the emotional and physical pain. She pushes everyone she loves away because she can't process the grief... until one small cut changes everything. "You're a walking corpse," I accuse the unrecognizable girl staring at me. Except you still bleed. "Cutting is the only thing that makes her feel alive. She knows it's wrong, but it becomes an addiction. When her family finds out, she is sent to an institute but even the professionals have a hard time getting through to her. Her family, friends—including her childhood best friend Jonah, tried to break through her walls, but they couldn't even make a dent. We all suffer alone, but we don't have to.
