

Beneath These Scars is a fabulous addition to Meghan March's Beneath series. Though it is a part of a series, it can be read as a stand alone. If you are a fan of Meghan's work, you will have met the infamous Lucas Titan. He has been portrayed as the villain; or at the very least, the guy you can love to hate. Though he was shown to have some redeeming qualities, and you may even have changed your mind about him after some of his unusual antics, you have not been introduced to the true Lucas Titan until this story. Yve Santos has vowed to never be a kept woman. After her abusive first marriage, she is determined more now than ever to make a life for herself all on her own. When circumstances beyond her control force her to be at the mercy of Lucas Titan, reluctant isn't even a strong enough word to describe her hostility and frustration. This book is filled with strong-willed, determined characters. The chemistry between them will have you laughing one minute and completely emotionally invested the next. Meghan March has an amazing ability to write gripping story lines that keep you burning through the pages to find out what happens next. I absolutely devoured this series and I hope to read more about these memorable characters in the future!

There were a few things that took me a second to figure out, since I hadn't read the previous books, but I caught on quickly. I thought this was a great story! I wasn't sure I was going to like Lucas at first, but he grew on me, and I came to really understand and appreciate his character. He was definitely cocky, demanding, possessive, and entitled...but he was also considerate, giving, loyal and smart. Plus super sexy! Can't forget that!Yve was outspoken, brash, intelligent, strong, unique and independent. Coming from a very troubled background, she became self-reliant, tough, and weary of trusting people. She did not want to let anyone control her or use her as a pawn. She was absolutely her own woman. These two had fantastic chemistry, and at first, that was all they had. They didn't necessarily like each other, but over time, and as their walls came down, they realized there was a lot more to the other person than they could have imagined. Both did share some similarities in their pasts, and as their relationship progressed I enjoyed seeing a softer side to each of them. This book had some action, suspense and surprises that kept you guessing. I thought the writing was good, the characters were really interesting, and the story line certainly caught my attention. I have to say that the epilogue was one of the funniest I have ever read. It was completely true to character, and although it surprised me, it really shouldn't have. Knowing Lucas and Yve I couldn't have imagined it any other way. I would definitely recommend this book and the series!!!

I began reading Ms. Meghan March back in May of 2015, with her title "Beneath this Mask", and have been a big fan ever since. I recently purchased "Scars" b/c I hadn't read Ms. Meghan in a while and I'm so super glad I did. I got to revisit some old friends like Vanessa and Con, Elle and Lord, it was a nice reunion on my part. haha But we've known Lucas for a while now and to say he's a jerk is putting it mildly. Now he's finally met his perfect match, Yve. And boy does she know how to put him in his place like no one else. It's great to see a bad man fall to his knees in love !! Yve has had a few hard nocks too, literally but she's no quitter. She's truly a girl I would like to meet in person. :

I finally forced myself to guit around 4 am when I was 30% of the way through Beneath These Chains. This was my first introduction to Meghan March and I'm seriously kind of pissed that I only just found her as an author. Her writing is clean, flows well, and is engaging - as proven by my reading binge. It's absolutely ridiculous when you consider she's a fairly new (published) author. All the characters are well developed, none of them are perfect, and each of them have very relatable faults. Even the minor characters who are only mentioned and rarely ever make an actual appearance in the stories. Each story is told in the first person narrative jumping between the hero and the heroines perspective. This allows the reader to gain insight into the characters you normally might not get from a third person narrative. Each book contains plenty of steamy sex, emotionally charged conflict, and just enough mystery and intrigue to make them your not-so-ordinary contemporary romances. Each can be read as a stand alone book, but why would you want to do that?Beneath These Scars:Lucas Titan, bad boy extraordinaire, is used to getting what he wants.
