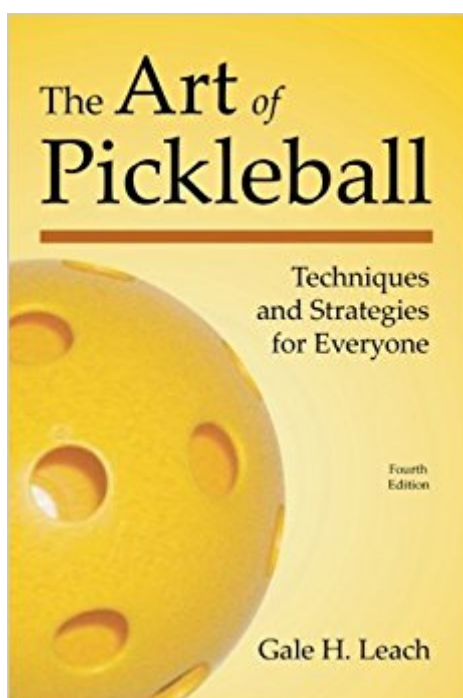

However, I really liked her diagrams of where, in the court, to expect an opponent's ball to land which clarified to me yet again, how important it is to be at the kitchen line. This has given me more confidence at the net. Just a simple thing but has really helped my game.

This book provides much needed information on basic techniques and appropriate strategies for the game. It would be particularly helpful to new players in forming good habits and adding other dimensions to their game. I liked that it sometimes offered more than one approach rather than a "one size fits all" solution. The book also assists experienced players in discovering flaws in their game and methods to tweak these weaknesses.

This book is for the beginner and the advanced player. From learning the basic moves and shots to strategy and tactics, there is something for everyone. It is also good for someone teaching others to play. I go back to this book for reminders and hints for better play.
