

I especially like the lists of trout fly patterns and fly shops. There is also a list of guide services which I hope to utilize in the future.

I managed to pick up a copy of this book and have been very impressed. The book covers a selection of the top Oregon destinations and provides excellent maps and straightforward

suggestions on what to use and where to use it. Good general advice is also interspersed throughout the book. I feel that with this guide one could approach a new river or lake in Oregon with a higher level of confidence. His writing style is informal and enjoyable, like a day on a river with a guide who you are comfortable with.
