

It was a stretch for 9th graders, but would be perfect for high school seniors or college intro.

This book would have been much better if it stayed focused on the issues and facts. Instead the author decides to make frequent historical political comments based on his opinions, that have nothing to do with the issues. These breaks from analysis of the facts makes me question his ability to deliver unbiased information throughout the rest of the book.
