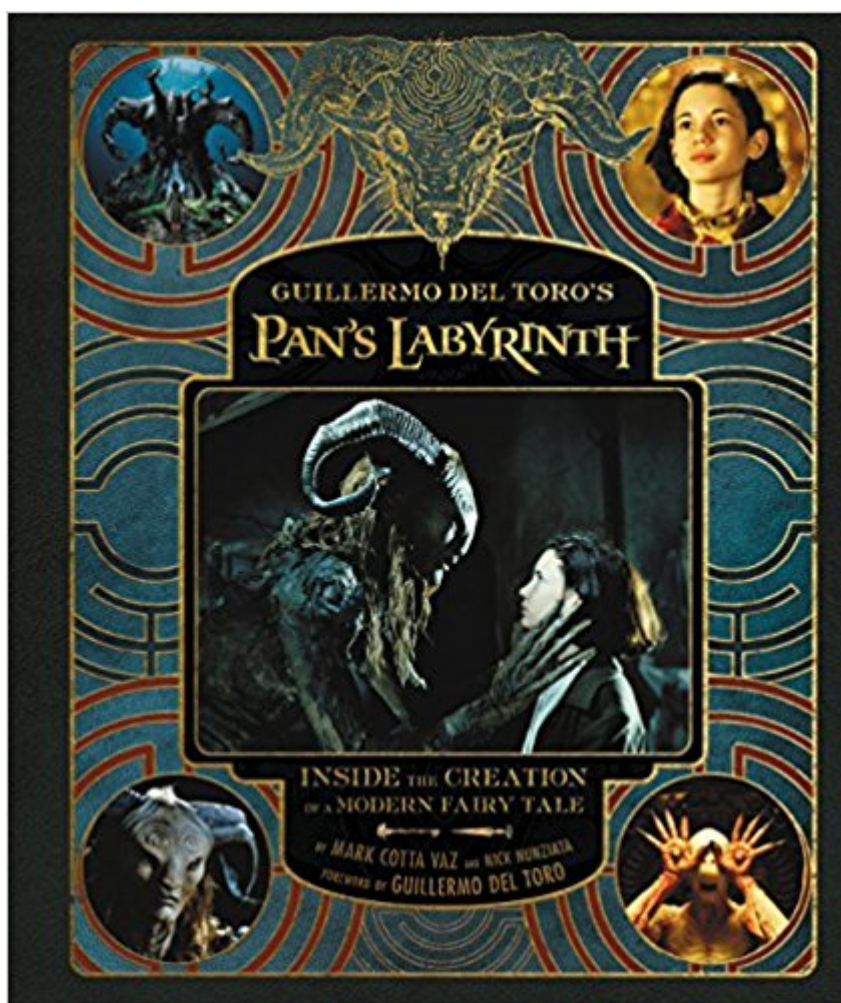

Born in Guadalajara, Mexico, Guillermo del Toro is the director of the films *Cronos*, *Mimic*, *The Devil's Backbone*, *Blade II*, *Hellboy I*, *Hellboy II*, and *Pan's Labyrinth*, which garnered enormous critical praise worldwide and won three Academy Awards. Nacido y criado en

*Pan's Labyrinth* is my favorite film, so my expectations for this book were mountainous. And I have to say that it transports me. The hundreds of drawings give an idea of the many iterations of creatures and conflicts, and the lavish and plentiful photographs show cast and crew trying to render magic that will not be seen in cinema the same way again. Through it all, one can glimpse del Toro intoxicating others with his visions -- those transmutations of Machen, Blackwood, Andersen, the Brothers Grimm, and more visual artists than I can name. For everyone who wants to go back to the labyrinth where Ofelia made her triumph and sacrifice, this book is the portal. Looking like the kind of book whose obsessions and images could attract curious fauns, I took it out to the woods to test it out. No fauns sighted just yet, but maybe when the moon comes out. Along with Insight's *At Home with Monsters*, this is the film book of the year for me, just as Abrams' *The Grand Budapest Hotel* (from Mark Zoller Seitz) was my first-pick movie book last year. This fall, authors Mark Cotta Vaz and Nick Nunziata, along with the editors and designers, have my complete wonder.

I'm one of those who believes that del Toro wrote a fairy tale wrapped inside a war, and not a frightened child's descent into dissociative madness. We're lucky to have this reference written in English. It is a good companion to the Spanish language book published in 2006 by Coleccion Espiral (isbn 84-96582-20-5), which has the entire storyboard of the film:
