

Say you just learned about Africa but you are really interested and want to know more, then you can follow the internet links and learn more for free. Also I like the cover on these books. It is so hard to find hardcover, but with kids you really need it, just in case. And with the hard cover this book will last you years to come.

My 8 years old daughter enjoyed the book saying: "I feel like being in an advanture." She finished it in one day then I started to deeply explain the contents part by part. The accompanying website is

really great to add more to her knowledge. Still, the touch and feeling of the pages and the colorful drawings are incompetent. The delivery was as fast as four days via DHL.

It's a good book, although I prefer the DK First Earth Encyclopedia, just because it has a lot more to it than Usborne. It's still a good book and I am using both to homeschool 2nd grade Science. It seems to be a little hard to get now, thinking it may be out of print.

I got three of these Usborne First Encyclopedias for my 5 year old daughter for Christmas. They are a little shorter and simpler than I expected, but she likes flipping through them. She asked me what clouds were made of one day, and we found the answer easily using the index. The page on weather led us to more discussion, which was exactly what I was hoping the books would accomplish.

This is WONDERFUL book for anyone who loves science and learning! It's very colorful and explains things on a simple level, which is needed for my young elementary aged children. I even enjoyed flipping through this book. It's engaging to the little ones almost IMMEDIATELY because of the colors, larger text and simplicity! The kids don't get lost by all the information. Very well done! We really enjoy this book!!
