

She is known internationally for her many wonderful books for children, including her series about Maisy. Maisy apparently does not have parents, or any family to speak of. She is injured enough to require

staying in the hospital overnight, but there is no mention of her family. This a very odd story to share with a toddler.

Cute little story. Since my granddaughter had broken her leg I wanted a book in which someone also broke a leg. Charming, colorful pictures make this fun to read to child.

We bought this for my daughter to help her process a trip she had to take to the emergency room. The story worked well to help her talk through the experience but the book's binding has already separated from the cover. She wasn't rough with it at all. Not sure what happened. Bad glue?

The simple and colorful pictures in these Maisy books are my grandchildren's favorites.

While visiting my granddaughter I had the privilege of reading Maisy Goes to the Hospital several times in one day. This is proof enough to me that this book garners the attention of children, both with the stories and the illustrations. Lucy Cousins is the author and the illustrator of this and other Maisy books. In this book the main character, Maisy, breaks a leg, so she needed to visit the hospital. This book covers many topics which can prove scary to children: being injured, seeing the doctor, going to a hospital, and spending the night away from home. This book is entertaining for children and the illustrations draw their attention to the details of the story as they follow along. My granddaughter and I highly recommend this book to everyone with children.

Lucy Cousins has created another wonderful Maisy book for children of all ages. Maisy is in the hospital which many children can relate to. This would be an excellent book to present to a child who did have to make a hospital visit, I think. The book is delightful and the illustrations are great. Maisy is in my opinion, one of the best series around for little folks. She is just great.

My children have grown up with the Maisy books but are now beyond the board books and lift the flap books. This range of books is the next progression on from those so I am delighted my children can still keep in touch with their favourite characters in a more in depth story. This book is very good. The Maisy illustrations are more detailed than ever. There is text on most pages and it tells the story of Maisy going to hospital because she breaks her leg falling off her trampoline. The best bits of the

old Maisy books are still here, the wonderful illustrations, all the friends and the crystal clear progression of the story. This story is also very educational as it introduces things you might encounter at hospital like X rays, plaster casts, crutches and childrens wards. It also shows the feelings you might have - homesickness because of a hospital stay but points out the good thing of meeting new friends. Maisy meets a new character Dotty the Donkey in the bed opposite her. Nurse Comfort, a flamingo, and Dr Duck also make an appearance. There are lots of things to count - 11 windows on the hospital, flowers on bushes etc It can also lead to a left versus right discussion as you can work out which leg Maisy broke. Highly recommended for 3-6 year olds especially those who are in plaster casts.
