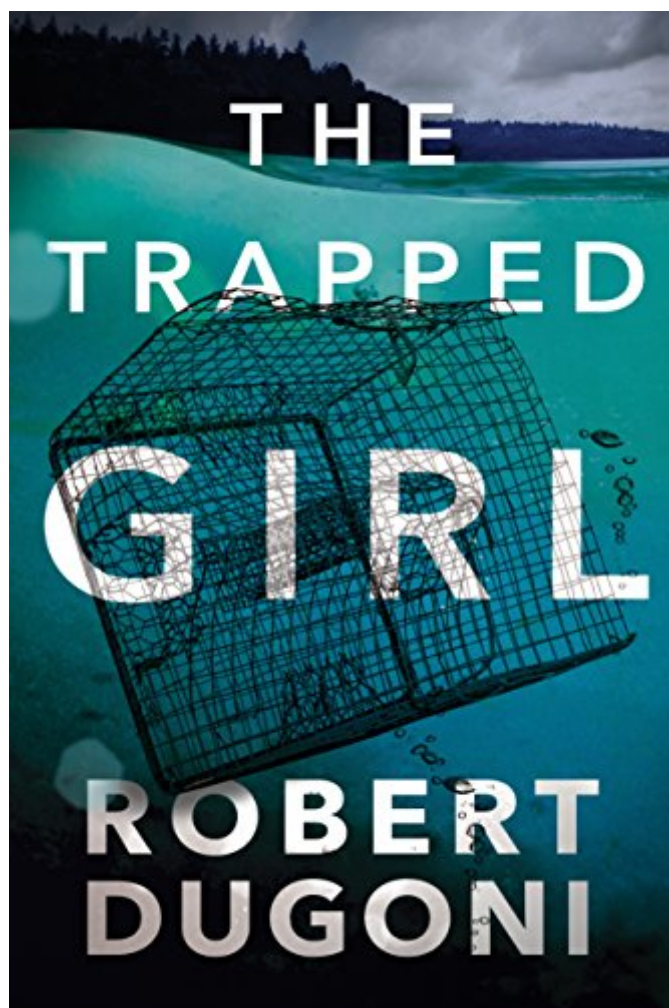

I just finished reading Dugoni's ,The Trapped Girl. And I want to read it again! Good title, by the way, our protagonist is indeed trapped in a very bad marriage with an emotional wreck of husband who would gamble everything away, even her protected inheritance. Our detective, Tracy Crosswhite, is as committed as ever to finding the murderer of the dead woman brought up in a crab pot in the Puget Sound. Tracy works with a good team of detectives who are on their way to uncovering the truth when their case gets taken away from them. Three bodies later, the clues lead in one direction while the solution lies in another. The ending promises to surprise you. In fact, I want to read it again to find out how I got there. The Trapped Girl is a great whodunnit. No doubt about it, you will enjoy this one.

Dugoni consistently creates a good mystery, with plenty of potential suspects and better twists than many writers. I took off a star for his description of Graham Sterling. He introduces him, "First impression? I thought Graham looked like something out of that television show, Mad Men, with his hair gelled and parted low on the side of his head, his suit a size too small, his tie too narrow, and his day-old growth too forced." A few pages later, " He had a personal shopper who knew his tastes, and Graham liked the way they tailored his clothes. He looked like heÃfÃ Â â ¬Ã â„çd stepped out of the pages of GQ." Then at least twice more he describes his suits as "a size too small" and once "pants short enough to reveal cream colored socks." Robert Dugoni is on a very hot roll currently. However, Dugoni is, also, IMHO at, or very near, the top of his game, too. I am currently reading the Tracy White police procedural/legal thriller series. The Trapped Girl is book four in this series, and the writing and the stories just seem to get better and better. I really enjoy this series, and this definitely was my favorite in the series. I have not read book three, yet. We can only hope that he is not having his ÃfÃ Â â ¬Ã Â "DylanesqueÃfÃ Â â ¬Ã Â • peak anytime soon. Let the songs keep coming. Kurt Schill, a Seattle teenager, is out trying to make a few extra



her life.

I feel as if all my reviews are repetitious. Mr. Dugoni is a wonderful storyteller, keeping me on the edge of my seat, teasing me with red herrings and dangling bits to be solved along the way. Masterful. I love that I figured out what happened to Andrea Strickland before the big reveal. I love that I was able to follow the clues and Tracy's methodical police work. Also to love is how I don't feel the research and dissemination of information to ever be daunting. I'm not used to how the characters talk, though. I get the feel for the police communication style down by the homicide team, but I don't see typical people speaking like Mr. Dugoni portrays them. Still, wonderful.

The Trapped Girl returns Dugoni to form in this police procedural with fun & compelling characters and an innovative plot. A relatively easy read, the plot is interesting, novel, and engaging. It draws you right in. The 4 main detectives, while shallow for a novel are nevertheless sufficiently developed for this genre. Dugoni recently released a horrid early novel, the 7th Cannon. It was so badly written that I considered giving up on this author. But with the Trapped Girl, he returns to his usual compelling form. Keep the new novels coming (but skip any early manuscripts that were never published).
