

Even if you have researched Victorian interiors, you may have a warped perception of how those homes really looked. Many books and magazines portray Victorian style as nothing more than red velvet and cutesy crafts. This book is filled with the real thing--hundreds of interior photos taken between 1860-1917. It reminds us that Victorian is not a single style, but a whole range of styles that were adapted and interpreted throughout the age. The houses range from rural structures to grand urban dwellings and represent all parts of the United States. Each period photo is accompanied by commentary that offers insight into the room's furniture, lighting fixtures, wallpaper, and floor covering.
