Over many long years, Chicu is handed off from one owner to another until he is brought to a parrot sanctuary where, after a long search, Big Blue finds him again in a heart-warming finale. Karen Dugan includes elements of humor to lighten Chicu's story, a tale that might be similar to that of thousands of other exotic birds that are trapped, smuggled, and sold into lives of captivity. Parrots are long-living birds who flourish in flocks with mates and families, flying freely and happily through the treetops; in their captive existence#151;which may be fifty or sixty years, or longer#151;they often endure isolation and a tedious, neglected life without proper care or human attention. Through more than seventy striking, full-color illustrations, Chicu's story opens a window into the life of these exotic birds whose very beauty leads to their imprisonment, birds whose unique qualities call out for understanding and care.

Always Blue for Chicub by Karen Dugan captures attention on the first page with the picture of tiny baby parrots in the hollow of a tree. A good combination of an interesting story with many facts about birds woven in, this is a great book for libraries, schools, and nature centers. So far two children (6 & 10) have read and enjoyed it, especially the page on how birds communicate at the end of the book. The images are lively, the color combination spectacular and I anticipate that Chicu's adventure will appeal to the child who will receive it on her second birthday. Other books by Ms. Dugan that I often read to children include: Ms April and Mrs. Mae: A Fable, If I Had a Snowplow, No Nap Today, The Wild Swans, The Emperor's New Clothes and Beauty and the Beast.

The visually stimulating, intricately detailed illustrations alone are enough to make this book a treasure. The author has taken a very important, morally relevant subject, and made it accessible to both children and adults. She chronicles the journey of a parrot's life, using humor and visual beauty to soften the edges of the serious topic while educating the reader, and listener. The illustrations

capture the distinctive personalities of the characters magnificently allowing the reader to instantly understand them and often relate them to someone they know! In addition to the story of Chicu, there are true stories of rescued parrots and detailed information about meeting and living with a parrot, as well as resources for further education on the subject. I highly recommend this book for parents and educators to share with the children in their lives. It will make you smile, tug at your heart strings, visually impress you, and educate you about the pet trade.
