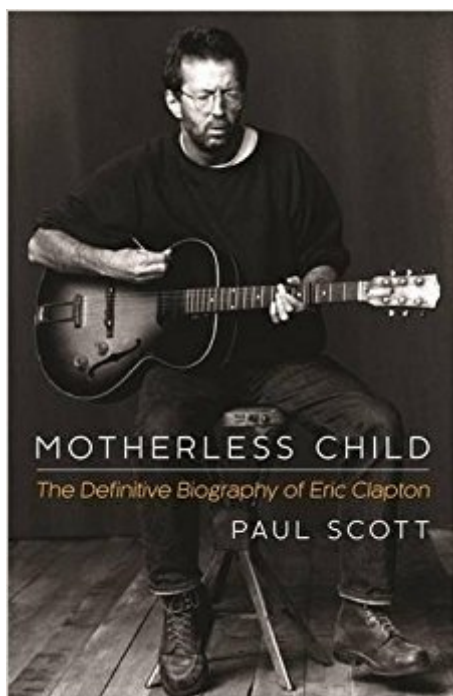

The book includes interviews with some people close to Clapton who have never spoken on the record before.
