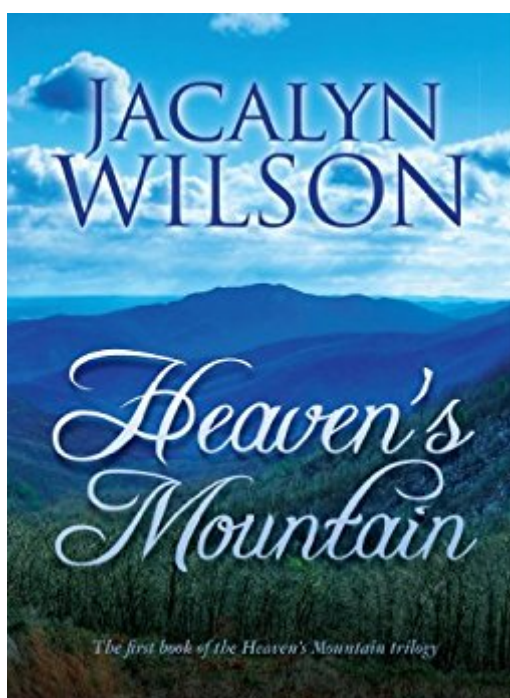

I'm not one for romances, generally speaking, but this book adds mystery and suspense in just the right doses. Once I started, it was difficult to put this down. This is an honest story. The desires, the skepticism, the hurts, the anger are expressed in down to earth terms with which anyone can

identify. I found myself drawn into the story, on several occasions laughing and crying and fearful as the tale unfolded. The writer successfully juggles several different characters, seamlessly transitioning so as not to lose the reader along the way. Woven throughout this well-written story is the sovereignty of God from generation to generation. I especially enjoyed watching the spiritual journey of the heroine from church-battered skeptic whose view of Christians amounted to a bunch of hypocrites and of the preacher who knew from the start he didn't have all the answers as they found their way to Truth. I can't wait to dig into the next two installments of this trilogy.

Again, this is part of a great series and I hope that everyone takes time to read these.

The Good... There were two really good things about this book: 1) a thought-provoking Christian message on living a Christian life of forgiveness, and 2) a smart heroine. **The Not-So-Good...** Writers are always hearing the mantra "show, don't tell." While there's plenty of showing in *Heaven's Mountain*, there's also a lot of telling. At times the reader is left outside the story, watching what's going on, but not feeling it with the character. There's also a bit of head-hopping during scenes. Sometimes a scene will begin with one character's point of view and then will, within a sentence or two, jump to another's POV. This can be a bit jarring, but it's not a deal breaker. I also felt the romance part took longer than necessary to tie up. There are several unnecessary chapters at the end showing a slow-building relationship between Grace and Ethan. I understand the need to show the two characters didn't just jump into a heavy relationship the next day, but I think readers can figure that out on their own. **The Overall...** If you're looking for a good, clean romance with a few thrilling scenes and with characters who make reasonably good decisions, I think you will enjoy *Heaven's Mountain*.

This is a well-written story told by an author who is obviously in love with the craft of writing. The narrative was an entertaining blend of humor, suspense and romance. The characters were realistic and had a laid-back Southern charm. The strong Christian theme provided me with thought-provoking theological insight but wasn't overbearing - just as any Inspirational Romance novel should. The ending was particularly rewarding in that it brought the multiple storylines together and resolved them in a believable way.
