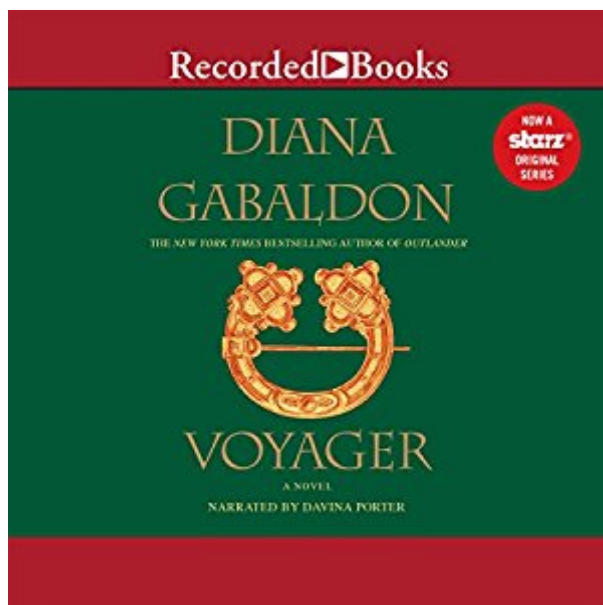

I finally, somewhat hesitatingly, began the first book. Maybe I was just too skeptical, but the back story unfolded too slowly for me, and I really wasn't hooked for quite some time. But, since my friend, and many other friends of hers, are completely crazy about it, I stuck with it. I wouldn't say I'm over-the-top obsessed like many others, but I am committed now, and determined to get to the end of the story! The story line is fabulous, weaving fantasy, relationships, and several love stories in with breathtakingly beautiful geography and realistic history, including wars, peace, and the hardships of a life in Scotland, before the luxuries we enjoy today.
