So, I loved this whole series, although for some reason the second book was my favorite. I've waited a few days to review this one because I wanted to make sure I had my thoughts in order.

Book two really focused on the relationships between the characters, and I think that is why it surpassed the other two. Rachel Marks has such a talent for that, for connecting characters and getting into their heads. While there was story progression in book 2, it focused more on the characters coming together, on the romance between Rebecca and Connor (who I totally shipped). In this one, the relationships continued to develop, but the focus returned to stopping Ava and there was something a bit off to me with the pacing. It seemed to read like a story that would require a fourth book, but it all wrapped up at the end of this one, but there's still, well, powers. That's all I'm saying. Maybe Marks is leaving a door open for more stories in this world?Anyway, this is a series I will likely read again. The characterization is top notch, the story world rich and plausible, the descriptions and voice wonderful.

I have had the great privilege of reading all three of these books and was so excited to get my hands on the last installment. Marks does an incredible job tying up the ends. Aiden's struggle to save his sister and the lengths to which he has to go are thrilling and heart wrenching. Rebecca's story is also a big focus of this book and shows another edge to the world that Marks has created. I highly recommend checking out this series. It's a great series for people who love books by authors like Cassandra Clare and Holly Black.

The third book in a series has always been my favorite and this is no exception. An exciting and tragic end of The Dark Cycle series. All come into their full powers. Aiden becomes an internet hero. I am sad it's over. Maybe there will be a spin off to the series.

The series developed well with some nice lore and plot turns in book one that continued into book two. However, in book three I had anticipated more character growth that never really seemed to materialize. Without spoiling anything the book vacillated between a slow plod and then what felt like a rush to the finish. It's too bad, because the first two books had a really nice buildup and I quess my expectations were too high for the conclusion.

I don't like some of the language and insinuation, but the spiritual world is a dangerous place and there are things beyond this life we know. This writer makes you think about them and has stretched imagination in a good way.

I'm not much into Young Adult Fiction, being well past the young adult age, and I picked up the first

book, Darkness Brutal, just because I know the author and thought I should give it a try. I have to say I was hooked from the very first chapter! The characters are so well written they come alive and for me that is what makes for great fiction, being able to really feel who the characters are through their thoughts and emotions.
