

Very useful and complete. Make sure you download to your phone so that the Google maps link to give directions.

I have been browsing the book, and haven't gone to Israel yet (really the ultimate test of usefulness). I have found the information to be of some help, but as with many other guidebooks the maps and text are poorly integrated, making it difficult to connect information with location in a way you can use. There is also not enough practical information about how to get around, travel times, etc.

Useful information although things aren't always in the place I would look for them. Maps are not terribly helpful for details but do give an overall impression of the area.
