

Humorous but serious, this book takes an emotionally stifled married woman into widowhood and beyond into rallying a retirement home into revolt. Is supposed to have been made into a film featuring Pauline Collins, it hardly seems possible she should play an elder person yet, but the book also suggests one is only as old as one makes themself.

This is a feel good book. Mrs. Caldicott was downtrodden by her overbearing husband and then again by her son. She learned to speak up for herself, and along the way helps other older people. I hope to read more by Mr. Coleman.

Being about the age of the heroine, I enjoyed the author's understanding of the feelings and hopes of an older woman, even though he's a man. There was a lot of insight and warmth about the other characters, as well. I really enjoy the books by Vernon Coleman - always gently humorous, humanistic and honest.

I loved this book and the main character especially. She was a suppressed wife who was released from that situation and became an angel unawares to many of the people in her surroundings and changed their lives. A real lift to the reader's spirits. At least it was to mine. I plan on reading more of this author's books for sure.
