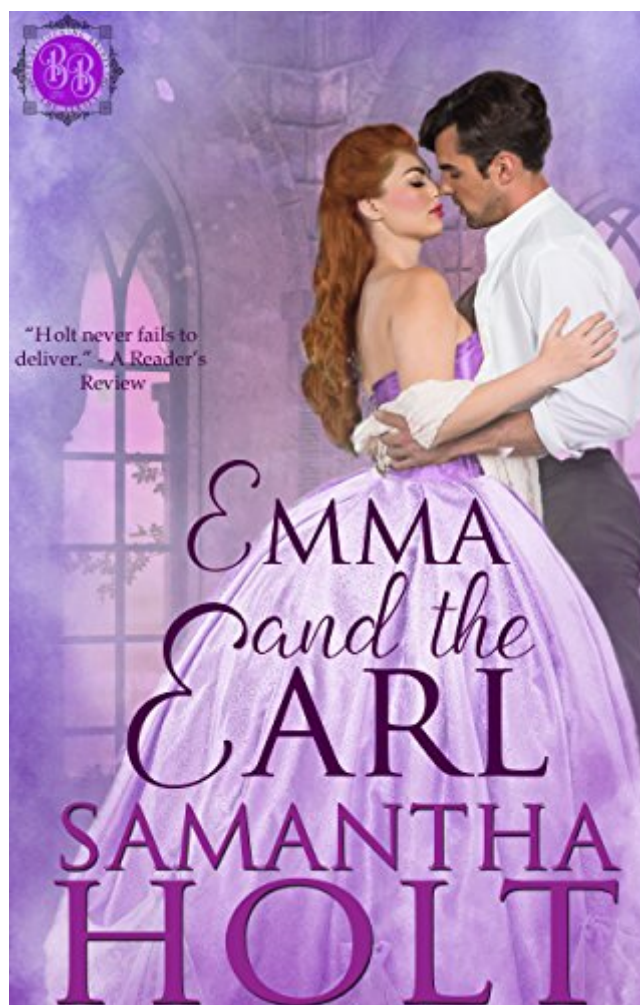

EMMA AND THE EARL is the third book in Samantha Holt's "Bluestocking Brides" series and although it can be read as a standalone, I would still highly recommend reading them all in order. This one has Morgan, the Earl of Radcliff (Guy's friend who was introduced in book 2) physically "falling" for Emma Chadwick, which results in him having to save her reputation with marriage. Add in an overzealous ex-suitor and a secret fear that keeps Morgan from being the husband he wants to be, and you have a sweet romance just waiting to be read...Once again, Ms. Holt has created characters that I couldn't help but fall in love with. Emma and Morgan were kind and intelligent individuals whose passion and connection was both believable and lovely. Emma was definitely the more genteel of the four Chadwick sisters, and while Morgan is described as a "rake" it's not really evidenced much. They seemed to settle into married life rather happily and also genuinely like each other, which was nice. Overall I thought it was a fast and fun read that engaged me from start to finish. At a little over 2100 kindle locations it was neither too long or short, and left me with a smile on my face when it ended. I did notice probably a dozen or so typos (mostly misspelled words) and think it could use some editing, but this didn't bother me overmuch. Since I've been looking forward to Catherine's story (who happens to be the youngest and boldest of the bunch) I'll be pre-ordering it for sure, and just hope it lives up to my expectations =)
