

If you like to read about unsolved cases and the misfortune that frequently befalls others, this set of books is for you. Otherwise, sometimes the connections seem forced, and I did not find so entertaining reading about the dark dangers that await anywhere.

Extremely informative & shocking. If you're not familiar with Jack Rosewood, here's a great way to get to sample his work. The stories are short and easy reading but complete with the crime, capture and punishment.

Florida author Jack Rosewood inherited his fascination for heinous crimes from his father, a journalist covering major grim crimes such as Ted Bundy. I've read all three of these True Crime compilations by Jack Rosewood when they were first published individually. Intriguing, and a nice simple style, not too long winded, straight to the point. I'm now hooked on this series! I just want to keep on reading them! There's some surprising material, a great variety of cases and circumstances. I've read a few true crime books before but these were all fresh ones for me, not all ones I'd heard about before (although I do like reading more detail about true crime cases I've heard of from years ago and in the news too). These are all medium length compilation books, each containing 12 true crime stories. Even though I've read quite a few of this author's books now, there's always something else you've not heard of before.
