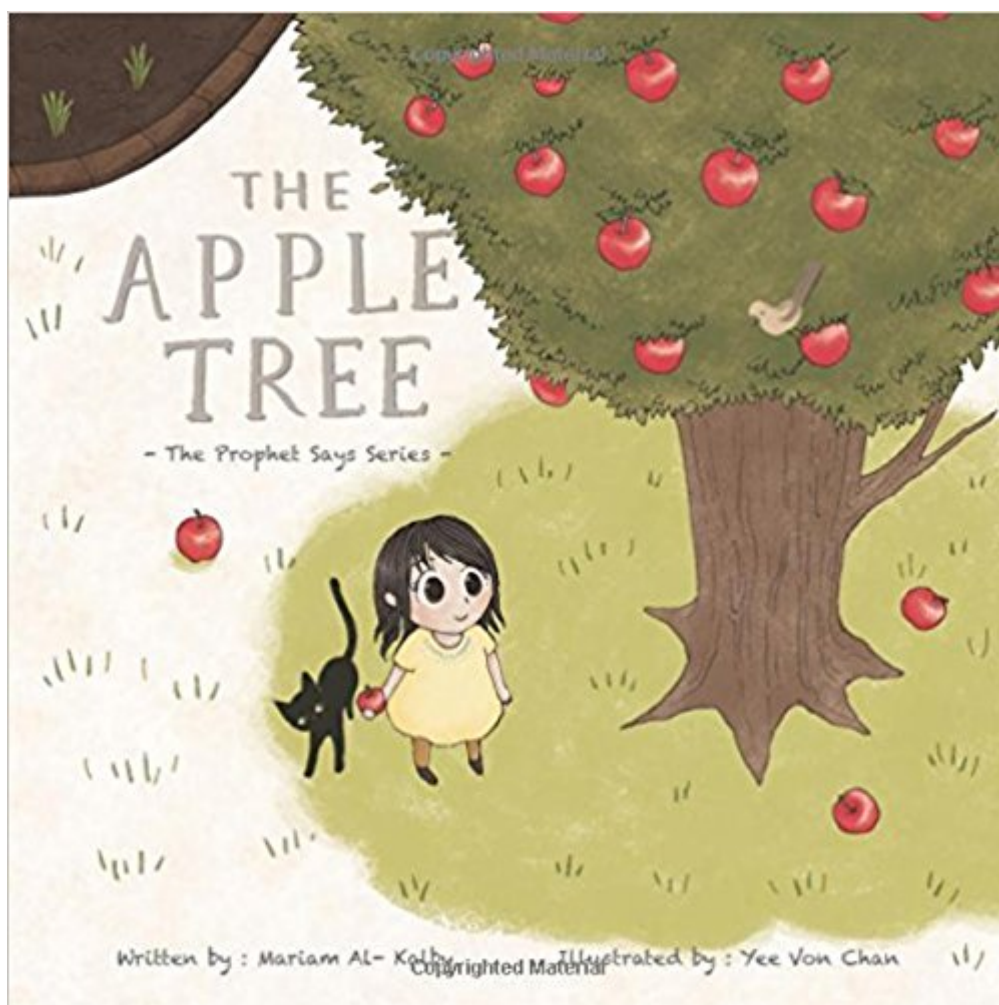

I think this book is very cute, great message. I'm very glad as a Muslim parent, we are starting to have a lot of options for books to read to our children. I hope there will be more, maybe a series? I don't wanna sound too picky, but my son is a new reader and the font chosen in this book is very thin and isn't the easiest for a new reader to understand. I would choose something a little bolder and simpler.

I bought this as a gift but read through it myself first. The art and style are beautiful and it's great to see an Islamic children's story that isn't just a story from the Qur'an or Islamic history (not that those are bad, it's just nice to see variety). I thought it was well-written. As others have said, there could have been a better font, especially for new readers--it's kind of a pencilly-looking font. The person I gave the book to was very happy with it and said it was "awesome" so I believe she plans to read it with her child. The one thing I noticed right away--as a white convert--is that the girl in the story seems to belong to a predominantly Muslim culture and is kind of ethnically specific, but I think that's important for many children to feel represented.

This book is wonderful and good quality. My two year old loves it ...the pictures are great and I just summarize the story and she enjoys the beautiful pictures. I am not Muslim but my daughter is half Muslim so from my perspective it has just enough info to teach an important Muslim lesson but still be a story any person would enjoy since it is about giving. Love the book!!

The illustrations are nice, but the characters' names are really weird, and there are too many words on each page for a bedtime story. Seriously, I don't even know how to pronounce half the names. It's on the top shelf of my son's bookshelf, where I hope he won't ask me to read it. :(
