

NPR has broadcast a number of hilarious conversations over the years, but these are not those. These are talks with people you would assume would be funny. It's mostly interviews with aging comedians - thus it does not appeal to a youth like myself who have only a cursory knowledge of Kathy Griffin.

My only concern is that the discs are only an hour each. I bought it to help me on a 7 hour drive. That's ok. I made them work on the dullest part of the drive and they kept me grinning and even laughing out loud all the way.

I love NPR and have listened to the "This American Life" tapes and CD's every time I go on a long trip. This one was a new addition to my collection and, being spoiled by "This American Life," I was a little disappointed. Some mildly funny stuff, here but no belly laughs. Of course, "Your Mileage May Vary."

I was disappointed. I usually love NPR stories and such. This was short and not very interesting. I expected more from NPR.

I had high hopes for NPR Funniest Driveway Moments, but this was rarely funny. It starts out strong with a great Dame Edna interview and then goes downhill. Not one of the following interviews is very funny. I don't think they were meant to be funny. They were meant to be interviews of famous people. Fine. But don't call it "funny."

This didn't meet the expectation set up in description. If you do get it though, I liked the 2nd disc much better than first .

Having had several "driveway moment" versions, I wasn't as fond of this one as others, yet it had many good stories.
