the cookies are good, but if you are a more advanced baker, you may be more comfortable with some of the more advanced cookies. The real advantage here is that you see pictures of every single cookie in hte book. you can figure out if you did it right.another advantage is that instead of having to deal with the binding while cooking, the ook opens upand lays down flat so you dont lose you page.
